## Infectious Disease Protocol for Spring Into Stanley

As always, Ride Management intends to try as much as possible, to reduce the spread of any equine infectious disease associated with participation in distance riding.

We ask for your respect and cooperation so that everyone can have a great ride experience.

Thank you

- 1. There will be no common water tub or dipping barrels use only the water hose.
- 2. We ask that you do not share tack or electronic devices such as heart rate monitors without disinfecting.
- 3. Pen or tie your horse in a manner that it cannot come nose to nose with another horse from a different barn.
- 4. Ride Management will supply soap & water for the judge and workers who are touching or examining horses.
- 5. Do not allow people to touch or pet your horse who are not from your barn.
- 6. If you have come in contact or exposed to a sick horse or have a sick horse in your barn, stay home.
- 7. No sharing of hay, feed or water buckets unless you are from the same barn/stable.
- 8. Make sure your buckets are marked for the halfway and place in the supplied garbage bag. Do not let your horse eat from another horse's hay pile or drink from another barn's bucket.
- 9. Hay for the halfway will be supplied from a non-infected horse environment.
- 10. Ride Management reserves the right to refuse entry and will not knowingly take an entry from a barn that is infected or exposed to any infectious disease.
